Scholarship Details

The Lynda Barrett scholarship fund was founded by the Norfolk State Chapter of Queen In You. In honor of Ms. Barrett being the founding advisor and also believing in the mission of Queen In You, a scholarship was made in her name for a current NSU student. The Scholarship will be awarded to any student who has a passion for learning and building the community.

REQUIRMENTS

GPA: All applicants mush have a 2.9 GPA or higher to qualify for the Ms. Lynda Barrett scholarship.

Open to: The Lynda Barrett scholarship is open to any current Norfolk State University student (all genders and non-binary). **This scholarship <u>excludes</u> incoming freshman and first semester transfer students**

Essay and/or Video submission: Applicants must submit an essay of 1500 tackling the given questions within the application. If applicants prefer, they can submit a 3-5 minute video answering the questionnaire.

Application details: A scholarship application must be submitted in order to be considered for the given scholarship.Applications will not be reviewed if the board does not receive it. Please read over each question carefully and only submit when all attachments are filled out. Applicants must provide two reference letters sent to the Queen in You email, by your reference, and one University unofficial transcript.
