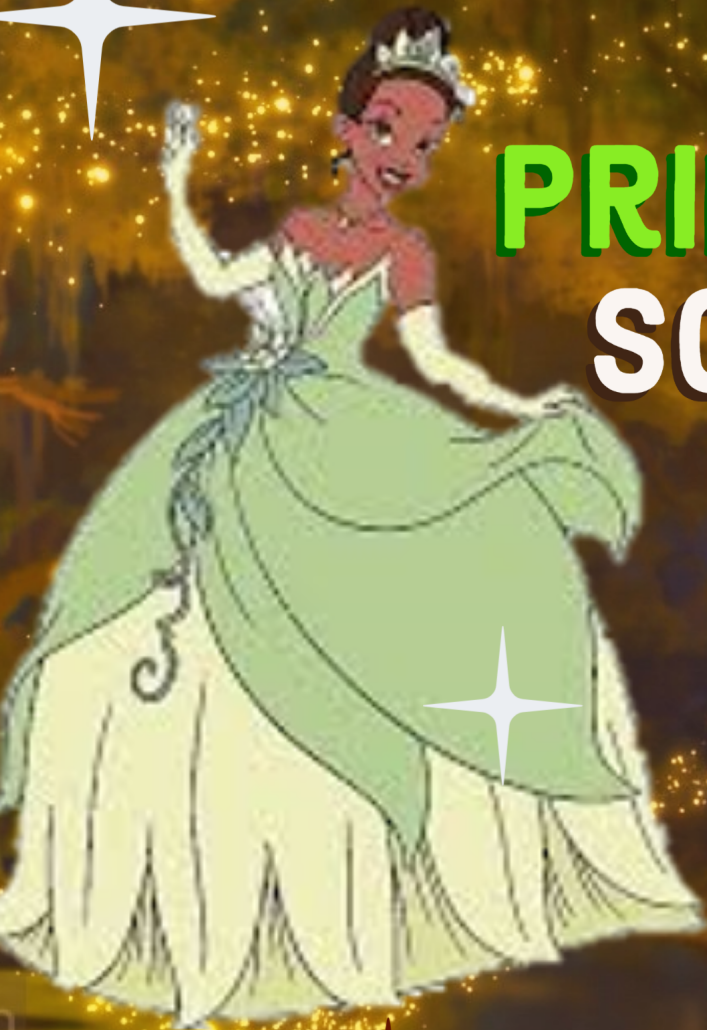

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

The Princess Tiana Scholarship was founded in 2020 by the Norfolk State Chapter of Queen In You. The scholarship will be awarded to an incoming freshman or first semester transfer student, in the amount of \$300, to provide additional financial support for school expenses. (i.e. books, housing, tuition)

This scholarship was named after Disney's Princess Tiana because she possesses characteristics that we as queens should possess ourselves. Her bravery, courage, strength, passion, determination, and compassionate personality allowed her to overcome many obstacles she faced and reach her goals.



REQUIREMENTS



OPEN TO FRESHMAN OR TRANSFER STUDENT

Applicants must be a freshman or first semester transfer student attending Norfolk State during the Fall 2020 semester.

GPA | 2.9 OR HIGHER

Applicants are required to have a 2.9 GPA or higher in order to be considered for The Princess Tiana Scholarship

ESSAY AND/OR VIDEO SUBMISSION

Applicants will be required to submit an essay (at least 1500 words) or video (at least 3-5 mins) answering the questions given.

****SUBMITTING both the essay and video is optional****

APPLICATION

A scholarship application must be completely filled out and submitted, along with any required documents, in order for the essay/video portion to be reviewed.



Essay and Video Requirements

FOR ESSAY AND/OR VIDEO SUBMISSION

Essay:

- at least 1500 words
- Top of page: First and Last name, date, scholarship name
- Title
- Size 12 font
- Times New Roman Font
- Double spaced
- Double enter and indent when starting a new question response

Video:

- Between 3-5 minutes
- Must send as an mp4 file
- All questions answered in full
- Must be recorded in a well lit area
- Audio must be clear
- Applicant must be visible in video
- Creativity will be considered
